I. Preamble

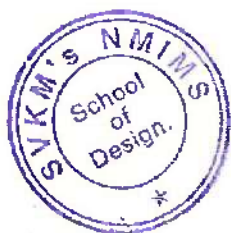

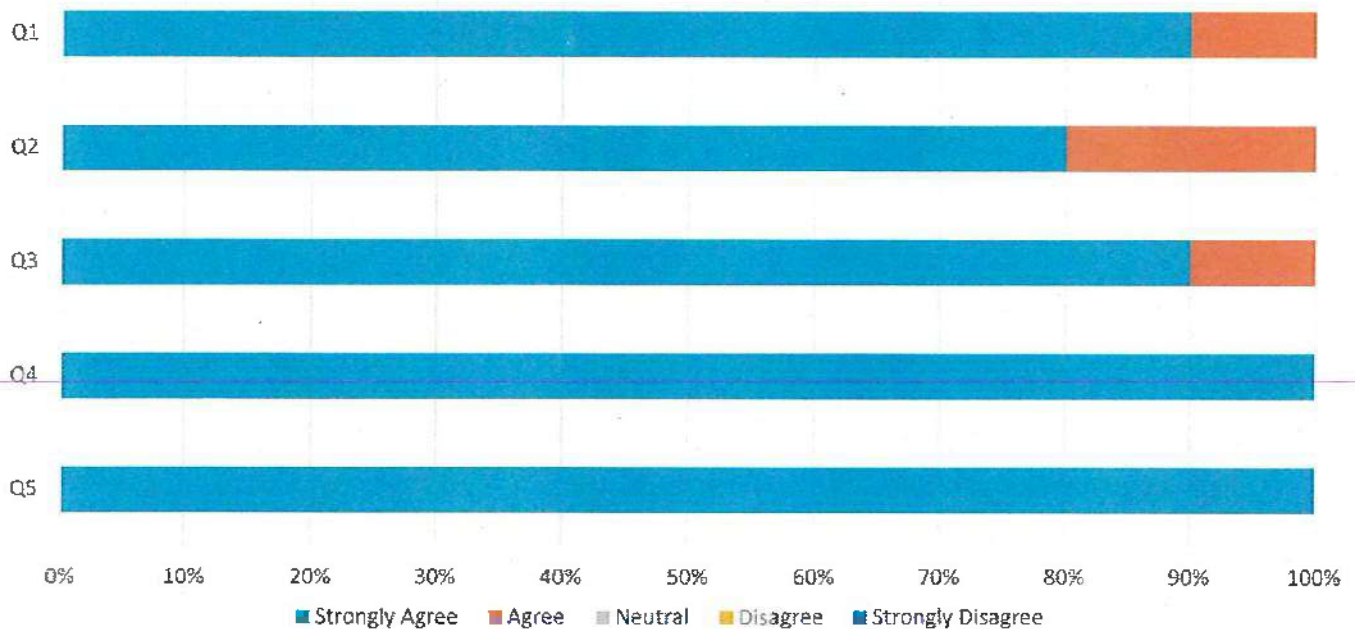
