NMIMS Deemed to be University has added to its impressive multidisciplinary lineage of imparting outstanding learning experiences, the School of Design. The nucleus of the school is to impart future-scoped design education to prime students to be design professionals in the emerging scenarios. Our AICTE approved, 4-year undergraduate program, B. Des. in Humanising Technology, resolves the problem faced by young students to make a choice between their interest in art, science and technology by offering a seamless amalgam of these streams. The program brings new focus on this aspect of 'multidisciplinary'—the byword in the field of design.

Internships are an integral and compulsory part of the curriculum for the B. Des. (Humanising Technology) Program. A student of this program is required to complete two internships with duly evaluated outcomes. The first one is a month-long NGO internship after the completion of Year II and the second is a five-month industry internship in the Year IV last semester. The objective is to provide the student an opportunity to apply their academic learning in a professional context, assess their capabilities, skill sets gain professional skills and return to academics with a renewed intent.

Third year in a row, we have achieved 100% placements for the batch of B.Des. (Humanising Technology) overcoming the challenging pandemic times. The program facilitated individuality in students by aligning their interests. Their acceptance to varied profiles, namely Associate XR Designer, Design Researcher, Solution Designer, Innovation Designer, Digital Product designer AR, Interaction & Technology designer, demonstrates the same. Top recruiters included Walmart Global Technology Service India, PWC, Axis Bank Freecharge, Human Factors International, MSCI Services Pvt. Ltd, Parallax Labs, SaathHealth, Beyond Design among others. Students were placed across sectors, with 20% recruited by E-commerce company, 20% by consulting firms, 27% in Design Agency, 27% in Banking / Investments, 6% in Healthcare.





As we witness the increasing influence of technology in every aspect of our lives, the Humanising Technology course equips our students to shape the future rather than be passive observers. It prepares them to address the complex challenges of our time, fostering a mindset of continuous learning and adaptability.

The competition, held at Stanford University, focused on optimising health span during long lives and attracted participation from eight student teams world





The theme of the Stanford Longevity Design Challenge 2023 was "Optimising Health Span: Living well at every age." Zeel chose to address the problem of menopause as a part of her capstone project for college. Over the course of five months, under the guidance of Professor Sajana Ali, Zeel developed a comprehensive solution to simplify the menopause transition process for women in their mid-life

Recognising the barriers women face in seeking support and obtaining information during the menopause journey, Zeel created a kit named 'Unpause life.' This innovative solution aimed to provide women in perimenopause and menopause in urban Indian society with a safe space to explore menopause-related topics, promote communication, and enhance accessibility

The Stanford Centre on Longevity Design Challenge has been a platform for students worldwide to showcase their talent and innovative ideas. Over the past decade, the challenge has awarded significant prizes and helped develop numerous products that promote healthy longevity. The challenge has awarded over \$250,000 in prizes over the past decade, and students from 69 countries have submitted over a thousand ideas, many of which have been developed into valuable products that promote healthy longevity.

Zeel expressed her gratitude by saying, "I acknowledge the invaluable support received from my mentor, Professor Sajana Ali, and Dr. Danit Ariel, assigned via Stanford, who played a crucial role in refining my project.
