This booklet gives information about the Admission Procedure and Admission Test for Programme B.Sc. (Animation and VFX) – Mumbai campus.

Admission to B.Sc. (Animation and VFX) (Batch 2025) is through NMIMS-DAT / **AV** (NMIMS – Design Aptitude Test for Animation and VFX) (NMIMS-DAT/AV

comprises of;

- **1.** Studio Test (Offline)
- **2.** Personal Interview (Offline)
- 3. Submission of Portfolio hardcopy. (to be presented to Personal interview panel as soon as the candidate is directed to Personal Interview room)

Only those candidates who go through all the three steps given above will be eligible and considered for the merit list:

Candidate can choose/ select the preferred date to attend NMIMS-DAT/AV in the registration form. Once date selected, it cannot be changed. Hence, select the date carefully.

<u>Please note:</u> Candidates who have appeared and cleared the UCEED Exam and have a valid UCEED score card by the registration end date, will be exempted (excused) to appear for the Studio test conducted by NMIMS. However, such candidates will have to submit the portfolio and appear for Personal interview as per important dates.

Duration: B.Sc. (Animation and VFX)) – **4 Years Full time program**.

4. Eligibility criteria for admission (Fulfilling all / applicable conditions mandatory)

The candidate must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination in any stream from 4.1 a recognized Board and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks. Mathematics **not mandatory** for this program.

- 4.2 **Diploma awarded** candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10+2 or equivalence examination with 24 grades/credits compulsory and has passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and TOK
- 4.3 **DP course** candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10 +2 or equivalence examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL)
- 4.4 **a.** IBCP equivalence for General Strand (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.

b. IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand: CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB. Further eligibility criteria as stipulated by statuary bodies like AICTE

- 4.5 Candidates of CBSE, ICSE, should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission
- 4.6 In case, mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 4.7 Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 4.8 **For IB & Cambridge Candidate :** Candidates who are called for admission on the basis of merit list & if they do not have their 10+2 or equivalent examination mark sheets, will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed only after the submission of the final mark sheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible. Mark sheet/Transcripts issued by Board/University only be considered (School/Institute will not be accepted).

- 4.9 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their (10+2) examination from Overseas Universities. Applicable to candidates of distance learning/ correspondence course/ open school too. If AIU not submitted, then the candidate will be considered as **not eligible**.
- 4.10 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board/University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA /CGPA obtained
- 4.11 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission is required to upload internet copy/ DG Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program
- 4.12 Only single mark sheet from single board with all compulsory subjects taken / opted and passed will be considered. Compartmentalized mark sheet will not be considered
- 4.13 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded/fail in mark sheet/grade sheet. For absent/ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.
- 4.14 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they must obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce the entire necessary Documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.
- 4.15 If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected/ admitted, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses.
- 4.16 Candidates who have cleared their 10 + 2 (12th Standard) by doing a part time course or through distance learning, correspondence course externally, open school from a recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
- 5. Admission Process:

5.1 Online Registration & Payment of Registration Fee.

- Visit <u>www.nmims.edu</u> for online registration.
- Pay registration fee of Rs.2000/- (Non refundable). Please refer online registration for payment details.
- Before filling the online form, please read all the instructions carefully mentioned in the admission information handout and important dates.
- Registration Fee is non-refundable/ non-transferable.

6. Selection Process - (NMIMS – DAT/AV)

Selection Process to B.Sc. (Animation and VFX) Batch - 2025 is through NMIMS-DAT/AV.

NMIMS-DAT/AV (NMIMS – Design Aptitude Test for Animation and VFX) comprises of Studio Test, Portfolio Review and Personal Interview.

Please note: Hardcopy of Portfolio to be presented to Personal interview panel as soon as the candidates goes inside the Personal Interview room as per the allotted time.

Studio Test, Submission of Portfolio and personal interview will be scheduled on one single day. Call letter to candidates will have the date and time and other related instructions. Call letter will be available to candidates on their dashboard as per date mentioned on important dates on website.

Instructions for creating Portfolio – School of Design, B.Sc. (Animation and VFX) - (Batch - 2025)

As Step – 3 of Selection process you are advised to create the portfolio as per instruction given below and keep it ready to be submitted at the time of personal interview.

Portfolio:

The portfolio should have minimum of 5 pages. **Please name the pages as stated in the table below.** Page1, 2 and 3 will be as per your choice, whereas Page 4 and 5 should include **Artifacts** Sketching and Rapid Sketching.

Contents of the portfolio:

The portfolio is primarily to display your best illustrations skills. They must be your own handwork creations.

- Page 1, 2, 3 will have **work as per 'your choice":** Showcase your best work, be it perspective/nature drawing /sketches /painting/photography/photographs of a model / sculpture, cartoon /comic characters you have made.(Any of the mentioned categories is fine)
- Page 4 should be **Artifacts Sketching**: (MUST HAVE). These sketches take time and capture the details of the Artifacts. Suggestive images are given in the reference section below.
- Page 5 should be Rapid Sketching. (MUST HAVE). These sketches capture the essence of the figure, nature, action in the use-context etc. They are not detailed and Sketching process is quick. Suggestive images are given in the reference section below.


