Q Why does the course focus on Humanising Technology?

Humanising tech means designing technology to be better for humans and better at interacting with humans. This is a transdisciplinary design program considering People, Technology, Science & Business.

Q Is Product Design/Industrial Design/Photography/Animation a subject of specialization.

No. These are the various streams we cover under the syllabus. For this course, there is no specific specialization, we focus on domain centred (Humanising Technology) learning.

Q. What is the admission process for enrolment into B. Des (Humanising Technology) program?

Step 1: Visit www.npat.in to Register for the NMIMS- NPAT 2020 Entrance Test + Design Aptitude Section (DAS)

Step 2: You must complete the Registration process by filling in the Design Form

Step 3: Based on the NPAT score, students will be called for a school-level entrance.

School Level Entrance comprises of: -

- a.) Studio test (Creative problem solving)
- b.) Personal Interview and Portfolio Review

Q. What is the structure for the NMIMS- NPAT 2020 and Design Aptitude Test?

Q Portfolio review mentioned in Step 3 b.) of the admission is a must or not.

A portfolio is a must where we would be testing your drawing and design thinking skills.

Q Are there any specific subjects required at School Level in grade 12 to be eligible for being admitted to the course?

Not really. For this course, a student may apply from any stream of Grade 12. He/she must have scored minimum 60% marks overall in order to be eligible.

Q Do IB Students have a different process?

No, they follow the same admission procedure

Q Is Internship a part of the Curriculum?

Yes, there is a six-month internship offered to all students towards the end of third year.

Q. Are there placement provisions after the course ends.

The School of Design does offer Placement assistance to the Students.

Q Are project fees and study material included in the fee structure.

Only Tuition fees are included in the course fees. Study material and project costs will be on a separate note.
